CALL BEFORE YOU DIG - IT'S THE LAW

As a property or business owner, you (or your contractor) are required by law to notify underground utilities at least three business days (72 hrs) in advance BEFORE YOU DIG ON YOUR PROPERTY. Call the Tennessee One Call Center (811) to have underground gas lines (and other participating utilities' lines) located at no charge to you.

CARBON MONOXIDE

Natural Gas is nontoxic and is the cleanest-burning fossil fuel available. Under normal operating conditions it burns cleanly, producing heat, carbon dioxide and water vapor. If equipment has a mechanical problem that causes the Natural Gas to burn improperly, it could produce carbon monoxide. CO is an odorless, poisonous and potentionally fatal gas. People who feel out of breath, dizzy, nauseous and have headaches or feel sleepy, tired, and/ or are more drowsy than normal -combined with any other symptoms - could be suffering from carbon monoxide poisoning.


What to do:
